INTRODUCTION

REALISE-Forum focuses on the analysis of specific support policy issues for electricity produced from renewable energy sources (RES-E). The Forum investigates the experience gained with national feed-in schemes (FIT) and tradable green certificates (TGC) as well as the feasibility of a possible co-ordinated approach in the European Union after 2010.

The project is co-ordinated by the Environmental Policy Research Centre (FFU) of the Free University Berlin and carried through by five national desks (Germany, Italy, Slovenia, The Netherlands, Scandinavian countries). These desks have been conducting a dialogue with national key actors concerned with RES-E. In fact, REALISE-Forum brings together stakeholders ranging from public authorities and the RES-E industry to consumer associations and environmental NGOs.

Major expected results are an actor-focused analysis of the interplay between liberalisation and RES-E markets, a survey of the consensus on national support schemes, the establishment of a RES-E stakeholders' platform and recommendations for policy.

In addition to national consultations, the project also provides for international workshops aimed at wider exchanges of views among qualified experts on some key topics. As the Italian partner in the project, CESI has been entrusted with the task of organising the first of these events and has therefore the pleasure to invite you to attend it and bring in your contribution.
